Event Locations

State Rally Events are held in various buildings on campus. Use the cover of this agenda to see what building your event is in.

Car Park-and-Walk Lot

These lots are designated for participants in cars who plan to park first, then walk to their event location.

Bus & Car Drop-Off Contraflow

Buses and cars must enter the drop-off route at Highland Road and Dalrymple Drive. Both lanes will flow in one direction following the arrows. Buses must use the right lane. Cars must use the left lane.

Bus & Car Drop-Off Zone

Buses and cars will be directed when to drop off students in the designated drop-off zone near the Student Union. After you've dropped off your students, you must continue along the path to your designated parking lot.

Bus Route to Parking Lot

Follow the green arrows to park in the designated Bus Parking Lot.

Bus Parking after Drop-Off

This lot is located off of South Stadium Road.

Car Route to Parking Lot

Follow the purple arrows to park in the designated Car Parking Lot.

Car Parking after Drop-Off


This lot is located off of South Stadium Road.
