Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Allendale High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Ms. Audra Murphy, AHS principal, for assistance.

The AER is available for you to review electronically by visiting <u>AHS AER</u>, or you may review a copy in the main office at your child's school.

For the 2023-24 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2022-23. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2022-23. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Allendale High School has not been given one of these labels.

Our school's key focus areas are to work within a Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) framework to use data-based decisions to elevate student achievement and to target instruction for those students who are our lowest-performing in identified areas. We are continuously seeking improvement in all areas and have consistent learning opportunities for staff to be able to implement the best instructional and assessment practices. We take pride in the growth and success of our students at Allendale High School.

- 1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL All students in grades nine through twelve were assigned to Allendale High School.
- 2. THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN Allendale is in year one of our five-year school improvement plan. Allendale High School is focusing on implementing a Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS).
