Classroom Values:

Academic Expectations:

Absence: When students are absent it is their responsibility to check the absentee folder upon returning to school to collect any notes or handouts that they missed. Students who are absent receive a grace period equal to the number of days they missed plus one to complete work before it is counted late. For example, a student who misses 2 days of school will have 3 days to complete any missing work before that work is late.

Late Work: All late work will receive a 5 point deduction **per day down to 50%**. Interim grade reports mark the mid-way point in each quarter. Any late work still missing by interim reports becomes a permanent zero. After interim reports, the cycle starts over, and late work will be accepted until the last day of the quarter.

Canvas: On Canvas students can view our weekly schedule as well as access notes and study materials. Students should check Canvas at least once a week.
