

All About Me Cube



Materials:

- Copy of “All About Me” cube handout, enlarged onto 12x18 white drawing paper
- Pencils
- Colored Pencils

Integration:

- Art History

Vocabulary:

- Communication
- Symbols

Directions:

- Great assignment for the beginning of the year to get to know students!
- Discussion:
 - How are some ways that I can learn about you? Writing, verbally, etc
 - How do people communicate now?
 - Before there was an alphabet or verbal language, how did people communicate?
 - Reference cave paintings, hieroglyphics, etc
- Discuss each section, what sort of information could go in each section?
- Students may start in pencil first, and may only use letters to write their name, the rest should be done symbolically
 - Discuss how to fill each section thoughtfully, not simply one tiny item in the center
- Students may add color. Check in with them... what material do they feel will work best to color? (typically colored pencil to get into small spaces/details)
- Once students are finished coloring, they are to cut out the cube.
- Demonstrate how to fold all of the edges backwards
- Using the flaps, tape the cube together.
