



Allendale Public Schools 2022-2023 Section 98c Learning Loss Budget Plan

Section 98c funds are available to local education agencies through Public Act (PA) 144 of 2022 (MCL 388.1698c) which was signed into law on July 14, 2022, by Governor Gretchen Whitmer. Section 98c appropriates federal funding to address learning loss as part of the Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund and part of the federal Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) II Fund. By October 10, 2022, at a public meeting of the Allendale Public Schools Board of Education, a presentation will be provided on how funding received under section 98c will be used to address learning loss. A brief description of the Learning Loss Plan is explained below:
