Don't worry if another small group shares your opinion and also finds and shares the same fact before you get a chance to; you can still share your thoughts to get your points.

Daisy	Some cons being huge capital cost, possibility of accidents, the burden of radioactive waste and more.
Jocelyn	Although we have said that nuclear meltdowns are extremely rare, it's not a 100% guarantee that accidents cannot accur
Ahmya	Building a nuclear power plant is extremely expensive
Atia	There is always a possibility of accidents. Under the extreme conditions, who is to say events of chernobyl and fukushima will not repeat
Amia	While some of these are decommissioning old nuclear plants and do not have new capacity coming up, some countries are phasing out nuclear power and switching to renewables w
