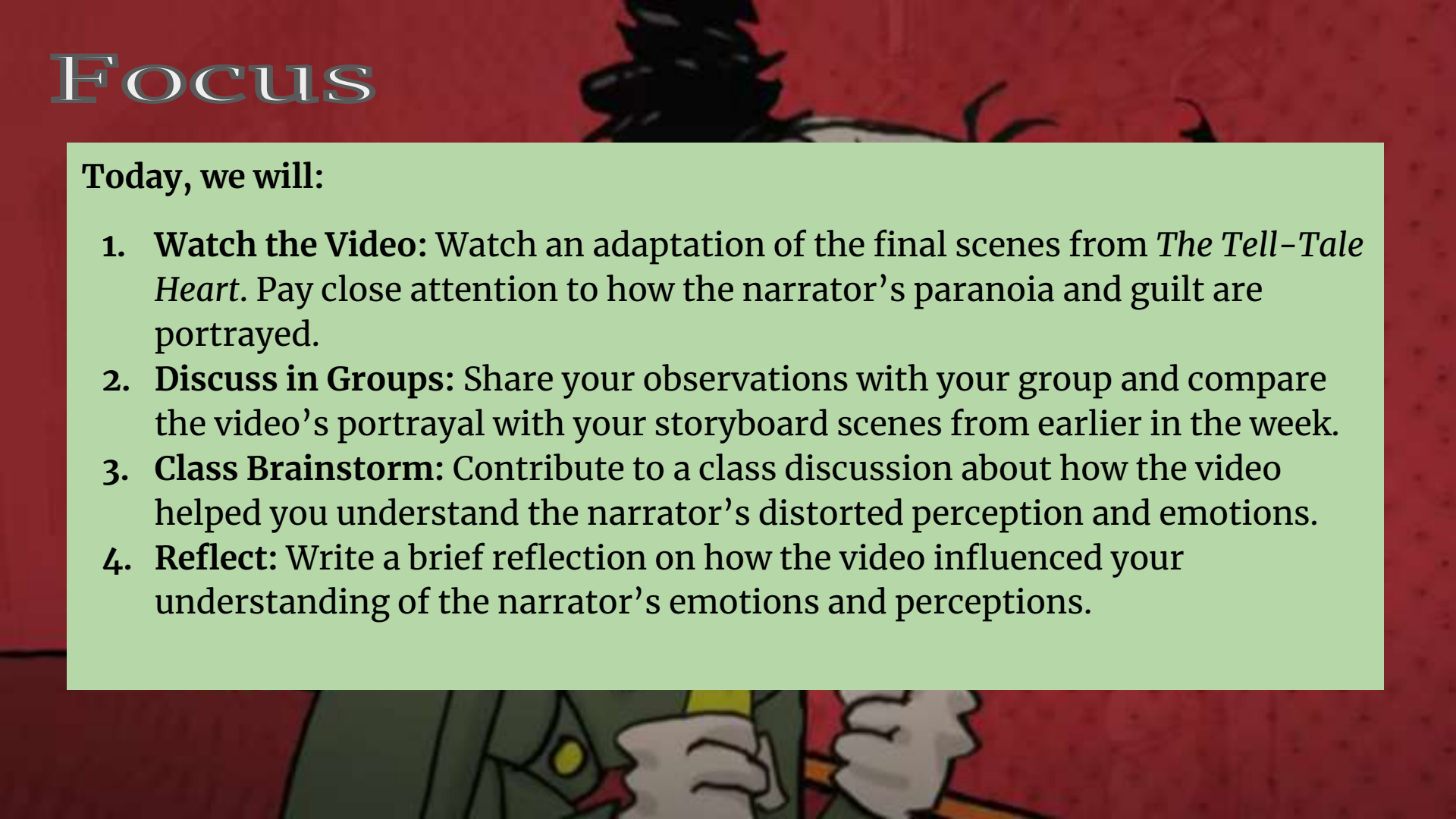
Analyzing Adaptations: Exploring the Narrator's Emotions in The Tell-Tale Heart



# Focus



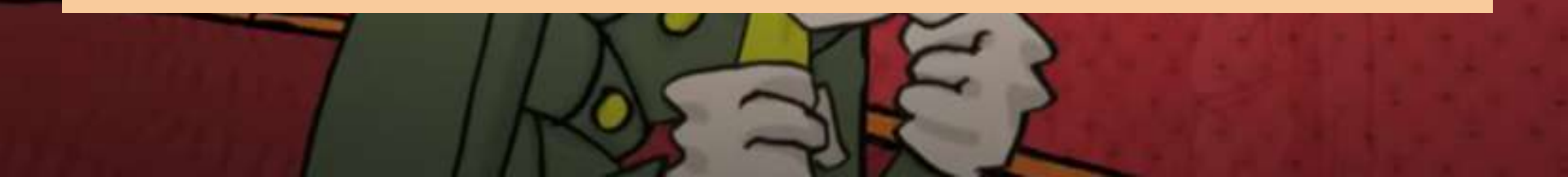
Today, we will:
