

Scholarship Guidelines for the Ann Talle Anoka Area Chamber of Commerce

These guidelines have been developed to help the Anoka Area Chamber of Commerce (AACC) determine an equitable format for the presentation of scholarships to the schools in the area. In addition to determining the parameters of the schools that are eligible for scholarships, it will also provide the general guidelines for the students that receive the scholarships from the Anoka Area Chamber of Commerce.

School Guidelines

- The public high school must have a graduating class of at least 100 students with a significant number of the enrollment of the student body from the area served by the AACC.
- The public high school must be open to any student regardless of the student's race, color, creed, religion, ancestry, national origin, sex, disability, sexual orientation, age, marital status, economic status, or status with regard to public assistance.

Student Guidelines

- The student must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.00 scale.
- The student must use the scholarship for continuing education.
- The school the student is planning on attending must be an accredited post secondary learning institution such as a career or business school, technical college, community college or 4 year college.
- The student must plan to major in a business related field.
