Lisa Sleboda joined Randolph Public Schools (RPS) in July 2021. She was the Assistant Principal of Special Education at RCMS last year and is the Assistant Principal of Teaching and Learning at RHS this year.

Prior to joining RPS, Mrs. Sleboda was a high school Special Education teacher, co-teaching English, Algebra, Geometry, and Algebra II, and delivering specially designed instruction through an Academic Support model. She held progressive leadership roles, including Team Chair and Special Education Administrator. Additionally, she was a Program Director at Bi-County Collaborative. She ran a therapeutic day program, life skills program, and multiple transition programs. It was through this experience that she honed her skills in the social emotional realm, having had the opportunity to work with a highly skilled clinical team. In addition, Mrs. Sleboda completed a year-long course of study earning a certificate in Trauma Sensitive Classrooms and Restorative Practices which reinforced her belief that discipline and student support must be married in order to be effective.

Mrs. Sleboda holds a bachelor's degree in English and two master's degrees: Moderate Disabilities 5-12 and Leadership and Education Administration. Her licensure includes Principal K-12, Special Education Administrator, and dual English/Moderate Disabilities 5-12.

As an educator, she believes that every child has the right to access a high quality education without barriers, she believes in fostering a positive school culture and climate to promote and support student growth and development, and she believes in the power of building partnerships with families and the community by providing opportunities for involvement and two-way communication.
