**Free Breakfast and Lunch for ALL Students:** Through the Community Eligibility Provision Program, we are pleased to inform you that the Dunkerton Community School District will be implementing a new option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School

Breakfast programs called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for School Year 2024 - 2025.

*What does this mean for you and your children attending Dunkerton School?* Great news for you and your students! **ALL** enrolled students of Dunkerton School are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2024 - 2025 school year. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit a meal application. **There will be a charge if your student takes extra servings**, examples – milk, extra sandwich water, gatorade.

**Free Student Admission to Home Activities:** All Dunkerton students will be able to attend home activities at no cost during the 24-25 school year. Students in grades 7-12 can gain free admission with their student ID. Students in 6th grade and below will receive free admission with a paid adult. This is for home events only. We hope to see many of our students supporting their fellow students next year!

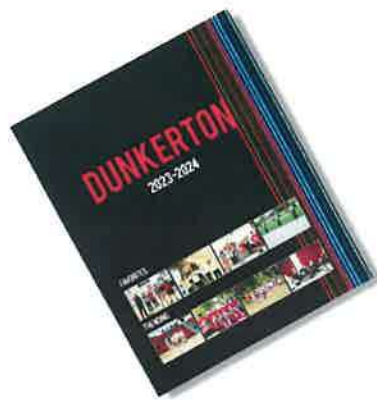
