Dear AP Exam Test Taker:

The College Board recently announced all AP exams will be administered **online** between May 11-22, 2020. For details on each AP exam test date and time, please refer to the insert or visit www.CollegeBoard.org for updates and to get valuable information to help prepare for your online AP exam. Also, be sure to check your EISD email for more AP exam updates from EHS.

Please make sure the email in your www.CollegeBoard.org student profile is a **personal email**, not an Ennis ISD email. You can make a free personal email at www.Gmail.com. This will ensure you have access to all emailed updates and the online test content. You can also access your online test ticket (code) 48 hours before you test by logging on to your College Board account. Also, in your College Board profile make sure you have the box checked to receive all emailed updates. If you are experiencing trouble with logging in to your College Board account, call 1-866-315-6068.

According to College Board, students who did not register for an AP exam by March 13, 2020 will **not** be able to *late register* for any AP exam this spring. If you have registered for your exam, but plan to not test, you don't need to take any action on exam day. On your assigned test day(s), if you experience technical issues after logging on to your exam, there are make-up exam dates available (see insert). If you encounter a conflict with a regularly scheduled AP exam date, please email eric.pierce@ennis.k12.tx.us with the reason for the conflict, so I may see if the conflict qualifies for late testing with College Board guidelines.

If you don't or will not have internet access or a device to test on for your AP exam date(s), please text @bbbc94 to number 81010 and provide your full name, grade, exam name, and a good call back number (cell phone preferred). Ennis High School computer labs will be available for online AP exam testing for those students without internet access or a device to test on.
