Dear AP Exam Test Taker:

The College Board recently announced all AP exams will be provided online between May 11-22, 2020. For details on all AP exam test dates, please refer to pp. 2-3 of this document or visit www.CollegeBoard.org for updates and to get valuable information to help prepare for your AP exam.

Please make sure the email in your www.CollegeBoard.org student profile is a personal email, not an Ennis ISD email. You can make a free personal email at www.Gmail.com. This will ensure you have access to all emailed updates and the online test content. Also, in your College Board profile make sure you have the box checked to receive emailed updates.

According to College Board, students who did not register for their AP course/exam by March 13, 2020 will **not** be able to *late register* for any AP exam this spring. If you have registered for your exam, but plan to not test, you don't need to take any action on exam day. On your assigned test day(s), if you experience technical issues after logging on to your exam, there are make-up exam dates available (see page 3). If you encounter a conflict with a regularly scheduled AP exam date, please email eric.pierce@ennis.k12.tx.us with the reason for the conflict, so I may see if the conflict qualifies for late testing with College Board guidelines.

If you don't or will not have internet access on your AP exam date(s), please text @bbbc94 to number 81010 and provide your full name, grade, and a good call back number (cell phone preferred). We will let you know by 5/1/20 if Ennis H.S. will be available for online AP exam testing in a computer lab setting or in another safe arrangement.
