The critique sheet is to help guide you in your art critique process. You should feel free to express your own opinions on the sheet. Many different people will have different responses to artwork. You do not have to agree with others on what you see, but you should be honest and thoughtful about your analysis.

Step 3: Turn it in

When you are done with the critique sheet, email it or turn it in to the instructor so that you can get credit. Make sure that your name is on your sheet and specify which of the gallery walks (which project) you are making up with this assignment.

What is the title of the art piece?	
What kind of artwork is it? (Drawing, painting, sculpture, installation, etc.)	
What media does the artist use? (The materials the artist used)	
List the literal objects in the work. (trees, rivers, people, buildings, vases, etc.)	
What do you first notice when you look at the art piece? WHY?	
Analyze	
What shapes do you see in the art work? Why do you think they are placed where they are?	
What colors are dominant? What kind of color scheme does the artist use? Is it monochromatic? Cool? Warm?	
What textures do you see? What role do the textures play in the piece?	
What is the overall feeling or mood of the artwork? How did the artist achieve this mood?	
What principles of art do you see in the work? (unity, balance, symmetry, asymmetry, variety, rhythm, movement, emphasis, etc.)	
Interpret	
What do you think is the artist's statement or message in this piece?	
What does the artwork mean to you?	
Why do you think the artist created this artwork?	
Judgment	
After careful observation, analysis, and interpretation of the artwork, you are ready to make your own judgment about the success of this piece. This is your personal evaluation of the artwork. In one or two sentences, give your judgment below:
