Advanced Placement (AP) Courses	College in the High School (CHS) Courses
Advanced Placement (AP) is a nationally accredited program of the College Entrance Examination Board. AP classes offer students rigorous instruction and challenging course content. All students enrolled in AP classes are required to take the AP exams related to each course. Certain scores on AP exams could potentially earn students college credit depending on where they attend. Students will be billed by CCHS for each AP exam in the fall semester and payment is due no later than November 1.	Cedar Crest High School offers several classes in conjunction with Harrisburg Area Community College (HACC) and the University of Pittsburgh (Pitt). These courses are offered on the CCHS campus and are instructed by CCHS teachers. In addition to earning qualifying scores, students that would like to earn college credit for these classes, must pay the tuition fees per course as determined by each institution. Students will be billed directly by the corresponding institution toward the start of the course.
