The questions are posted on a Canvas Sandbox page to which each student on the list I received from guidance has been invited to join.

If you are not willing to read and read a lot, this class is not for you. You cannot get by in the class with reading summaries as the task of the course is for you to learn to analyze the author's use of language in novels, short stories and poetry. If you read chapter summaries instead of reading the novel, you are reading someone else's use of language and only experiencing a description of the plot which is not necessarily the most relevant aspect to our study.

Write your answers to all of the questions for each novel on a Google doc. I will not accept the work in any other format. Don't copy and paste from the internet, another student, or use ChatGPT. If any of these methods seem like a good idea for you, this is probably not the class for you.
