Dear AP Parents and Students,

AP exams are quickly approaching! The schedule and location of each exam is outlined below.

**All students taking morning exams need to report to their exam location at 7:30 a.m.** Testing will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. - **late entries to AP exams are prohibited by College Board.** Please arrange transportation other than buses as your prompt arrival at 7:30 a.m. is imperative. Students taking a morning exam will be allowed to go to lunch after the exam and then are expected to report to 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> blocks. Students leaving school after their exam must have a note from their parent and this absence will be noted as unexcused.

**All students taking afternoon exams need to report to their exam location at 11:30 a.m.** **Late entries are prohibited by College Board.** Students taking an afternoon exam will be allowed to eat lunch prior to the exams. These exams may run past the 3:00 p.m. dismissal; therefore, please arrange for appropriate transportation. Students taking an afternoon exam are expected to report to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> blocks.

**\*\*Students with approved College Board accommodations need to see Mrs. Austin for exam locations.\*\***

Students should bring two sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers), two black or blue pens, and an approved calculator (and extra batteries) for those tests that allow them.
