

# APA Style Guide – Red Land High School 2018-2019

APA (American Psychological Association) style is most commonly used to cite sources within the social sciences. This handout, revised according to the 6th edition, second printing of the APA manual, offers bibliography examples for an APA research papers.

## Basic Format for Books

Author, A. A. (Year of publication). *Title of work: Capital letter also for subtitle*. Location: Publisher.

**Note:** For "Location," you should always list the city and the state using the two letter postal abbreviation without periods (New York, NY).

### BOOK – PRINT

#### Book by a single author

*The American renaissance*. (2004). Philadelphia, PA: Chelsea House.

#### Book by two authors and edition

Reilly, M. J., & Jermyn, L. (2004). *Mexico* (2nd ed.). New York, NY: Marshall.

Note: If more than seven authors, only list the names of the first six authors and the final author. Use a ... to indicate some are not listed.

#### Book with two editors, no author

Duncan, G. J., & Brooks-Gunn, J. (Eds.). (1997). *Consequences of growing up poor*. New York, NY: Russell Sage Foundation.

#### Multivolume work with editor

Sadie, S. (Ed.). (1980). *The Grove Dictionary of Music and Musicians* (Vols. 1-10). New York, NY: Scribner's.

#### eBook

Stoker, B. (1897). *Dracula* [Kindle DX version]. Retrieved from Amazon.com

#### Book in a Database (NO period at the end)

Rogers, F. (2005). Southern flying squirrel. In *Encyclopedia of animals*. Retrieved from <http://search.ebscohost.com>

Lesko, L.H. (2018). Tutankhamun. In *World Book Student*. Retrieved from <https://www.worldbookonline.com/student-new/#/article/home/ar571760>

## ARTICLE FROM A DATABASE or INTERNET

Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (Date of publication=Year, month day). Title of article.  
Title of Journal, volume number, page range. Retrieved from  
<http://www.someaddress.com/full/url/>

NOTE: APA does not use abbreviations for the months.

\***DOI** is a unique digital object identifier assigned by the publisher. It can be used in place of the database URL.
