Student-Teacher Contact Requirements

Apex Learning online teachers are readily available to students throughout the duration of the course. Online teachers hold regularly scheduled office hours where they are accessible online and via phone. Online teachers provide one-on-one support or group instruction during this time, as needed. Additionally, online instructors are committed to responding to emails within one school day, and grade and return homework with quality formative feedback within three school days.

Typical Day: Students email their online teacher with questions as they progress through their coursework. They have the option to communicate with their online teacher during office hours and attend mini-lessons using a live whiteboard platform. As they complete activities, they submit assignments and receive formative feedback via a secure message center. They participate in monitored discussions with their teacher and peers.
