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REPORTS

Dr. Mary T. Kelly, Superintendent of Schools, reported on an exploratory initiative on block scheduling at the secondary level. The Student Advisory Committee, which includes parents, students, teachers and administrators, has met to discuss different aspects of the schedule and the needs of the students. She shared that the committee will be visiting the King Park Schools to see how block scheduling works in the Middle and High Schools.

This month, Ms. Pawlewicz, Ms. McDonough, Ms. Santos, and Dr. Kelly met with Mayor Siry, to discuss a request made by Mayor Dennis Siry to honor Mr. William Kretz, a longtime resident, teacher, and administrator in the Amityville School District. A committee will be formed to establish a Hall of Achievement, which will be named in honor of Mr. Kretz.

Last Saturday the District held a Diversity Hiring Fair to fill positions that will be available for the 2019-2020 school year as a result of faculty retirements on June 30, 2019. This event was very successful in identifying candidates to move forward in our hiring process.

Mr. Farkas, Ms. Pekar and Dr. Kelly met with representatives from the Maurer Foundation to discuss ways in which the District can incorporate a Breast Health Program for our schools and community.

At the end of March, Ms. Pawlewicz, Ms. McDonough, Ms. Benard-Handler and Dr. Kelly attended the National School Boards Association Convention, which was held in Philadelphia.

The Amityville School District has received the honor of being named one of the Best Communities for Music Education.

COMMUNITY COMMENTS ON NON-AGENDA ITEMS

Carolyn Chikazunga asked how many positions were filled as a result of the Diversity Fair. Dr. Kelly responded that we are still in the process. Ms. Chikazunga also asked about a study that was conducted in promoting diversity in the professional staff? Dr. Kelly responded that Dr. Coverdale did a training with the District.

Rev. Alexia B. Huart talked about the use of Smartboards in the classrooms. She also asked if the Black Colleges Tour would continue in the next school year? Dr. Kelly responded yes.

Dr. Kelly responded that some ideas include: making a presentation to the School Board, hosting an information night in various schools, and posting information on the District Website.
