5th & 6th Grade Band & After School Intramural Choir Concert Information



We are very pleased to announce that we will be able to offer a live performance to showcase our talented students' work! We have put together protocols to keep students and audience members safe. Please read the following information carefully and let us know if you have any questions.

Concert Date:

5th Grade Band - Tuesday, April 20, 2021 at 6:00 pm (concert to end by 6:40 pm) 6th Grade Band and Intramural Choir - Tuesday, April 20, 2021 at 7:15 pm

Band Information:

- 5th grade Band students will arrive at 5:45, through the west (bus entrance) doors and proceed to the cafeteria where they will unpack, 6 feet apart.
- 6th grade band students will arrive at 7:00, enter through the north (staff parking lot entrance) and proceed to the cafeteria where they will warm up 6 feet apart.
- The band will warm up and proceed to the gym, one section at a time.
- Band students will be seated 6+ feet apart, and perform on the north/main bleachers.
- Students will be dismissed from the bleachers to pack up in the cafeteria, and meet family outside the same doors from which they entered.
- While the students are packing up, the audience will be directed out the same doors from which they entered.

Intramural Choir Information:

- 6th grade choir students will arrive at 7:00, enter through the north (staff parking lot entrance) and proceed to the band room where they will warm up 6 feet apart. Students who are also in band will warm up with the band first.
- Choir students will move to the gym to stand 6+ feet apart, and perform on the north/main bleachers.
- Students will play tone chimes and sing with masks on.
- Choir students who are not in band will watch the band performance while standing in the back of the gym, 6+ feet apart from each other

Concert Attire:

 Brightly-colored shirt, t-shirt, or sweater. This is a celebration! Choir or band shirts and Woodland Intramural Shirts are acceptable. Nice-looking jeans, pants or skirts (no sweatpants), keep in mind that students will be performing on the bleachers, so skirts need to be knee length or longer. Shoes should be comfortable, to make it easy to climb the bleachers.

Audience:

- The audience will be seated on the gym floor in family pairs. Due to space limitations, there will only be two guests per student performer admitted. Pairs of chairs will be 6 feet apart. Seats will be assigned. Where possible, family members will be seated on the side in which their child will be performing.
- We ask that members of the audience, as well as our student musicians, please stay home if they are not feeling well. Prior to visiting campus, we ask those joining us for the Spring Concert to conduct a <u>brief healthscreen</u>.
- The performance will be recorded, and put on YouTube for siblings, family and friends to enjoy.

Virtual Students

 Virtual students will join the performance via Google Meet or are welcome to join in person if they wish.

Masking and Distancing

 All students and audience members will be required to wear masks and observe social distancing protocols. Families will not be able to congregate inside the building prior to or following the performance.

Attention Virtual Learning Families: I wanted to take a moment to reach out to virtual learning families. As I mentioned in a newsletter towards the beginning of the year, I am available, if requested, to meet with your student virtually or supply other online resources for your consideration. All virtual learners have had the opportunity to participate in classroom guidance this year. Both 5th and 6th graders have had 2 full units of guidance, which is the same as their in-person peers.
