I would like to send a kindly reminder to all of you who pick up and drop off students at Miller.

Our situation is not ideal with the maze of a front parking lot and the buses being in the back as well as all the staff parking. However, we need to be sure we are keeping our students safe. Please follow the plan below when you are dropping off or picking up your child:

At the front of the building

• When dropping off in the morning or picking up in the afternoon, use the drive through only for a quick drop off or pick up. If you need to talk with your child, make a phone call or come into the school, please park in a parking spot and either walk with your child into the school or have them walk into the school using the crosswalk with Miss Della orchestrating the passing of people and cars.

At the back of the building

- If you are dropping off in the morning, please do not use the bus drive way after 8:30 AM. This drive is for buses only. Please park your car and walk your child to the gym doors where Mrs. Campbell will be waiting to let your student in the school. When you are picking up after school please park your car and walk up to the back sidewalk to pick up your child. No child should be walking to the back parking lot by his/her self. If you have a large vehicle, please use the lower lot to park your car while you pick up your child.
- Adults cannot enter the back of the building 8:00 AM 4:00 PM. If you need to enter the building, please come to the front parking lot.

Miller on the Move has started!

The spring session will run 4 weeks from April 25th- May 20th and will be every Monday, Wednesday and Friday at lunch recess. This program is supported and funded by the PTO and encourages our kids to be active. They can run, walk, skip, or even hop on crutches as some injured participants have done in the past to get their laps. The miles are cumulative from fall and spring and there will be prizes to be awarded for a 5k, 10K, half marathon, marathon and ultra-marathon at the end of the year.

With the increase in how many kids are achieving high miles, there will be a difference in the prizes handed out at the end of the year from last year at the end of year assembly. The feet prizes will remain the same, little feet will be handed out for each mile that they "run" (5 laps). The big feet will be handed out for 5K, 10K, half-marathon, marathon, and ultra-marathon.
