Hello boys and girls! I miss hearing your beautiful voices!! Let's have some music FUN!!

- 1. It's Spring time and the flowers are already starting to bloom. Hooray!! Soon you'll hear the buzzing sounds of bumblebees all around. Say the "Bee, Bee, Bumblebee" chant and flap your wings as you say it. Now use a little "high" sounding baby bumblebee voice as you chant. Next, use a "low" sounding grandpa voice as you chant.
- 2. Bees love to visit the apple trees so let's say the "I Climbed Up the Apple Tree" chant together. First use your regular speaking voice, then a high baby voice then a low grandpa voice. Remember to whisper at the end!
- 3. Now it's time to use our singing voice! We need to wake up "Lazy Mary" because she slept too late and missed the bus. Pat your hands on your lap as you sing. First, sing slowly then go a little faster.
- 4. Today, I'm going to teach you a new song. It's called "There's Someone Living on a Big High Hill." I will send you a recording of me singing it so you can listen and learn it too. In the song, you will hear me sing "Yoohoo." After I sing it, I would like you to sing "Yoohoo" back to me, like an echo! Listen to it 2 times and then try to sing the "Yoohoo." You can march around in a circle while you sing if you would like!

- 5. Now, I'd like for you to find a stuffed animal or toy and gently rock it while you sing "Bye Baby Bunting."

 Remember to rock gently and sing in a quiet voice because this song is a lullaby.
- 6. Today we're going to use our listening ears and learn about the different sounds we hear in the Spring. I'd like for you to use your ipad and go to the website called scholastic.com/learnathome. When choosing your grade level, click on the Pre K-Kindergarten grade button. Find where it says Week 1: Day 5- Seasons-Spring. You will see a video there called "The Sounds of Spring." Click on and then watch the video. When the weather is nice you can go outside and listen for the sounds of Spring around your house! Try and make some high chirping sounds like the birds in the video. Flap and chirp all around your yard or living room! I hope you enjoy learning all about the wonderful Spring sounds!
