Assignment

- You will write a journal narrative from the perspective of a merchant trader who sells beer, wine, spirits, coffee, tea, or coca-cola. Your journal MUST have at least 5 entries and should highlight how the beverage was traded geographically. Your journal entries should also give a solid understanding of the history of the beverage. Highlighting how it was celebrated, traded, and used. Each journal entry should be at least 3 paragraphs long.
- Your journal SHOULD be a period piece (for example, if you are writing about beer then you should be writing from the perspective of a merchant trader living in Ancient Mesopotamia or Ancient Egypt).
- <u>Writing Advice This is Important!</u>
 - Write in the past tense
 - Use an active voice with precise words
 - Explain key terms and vocabulary
 - Anticipate counter claims to your story
 - o Remain objective
 - Stay on topic

 For this class we will begin our history of the world in 1200 C.E. Naturally, you would want to know what happened before that (approx. 3000 B.C.E. – 1200 C.E.).
