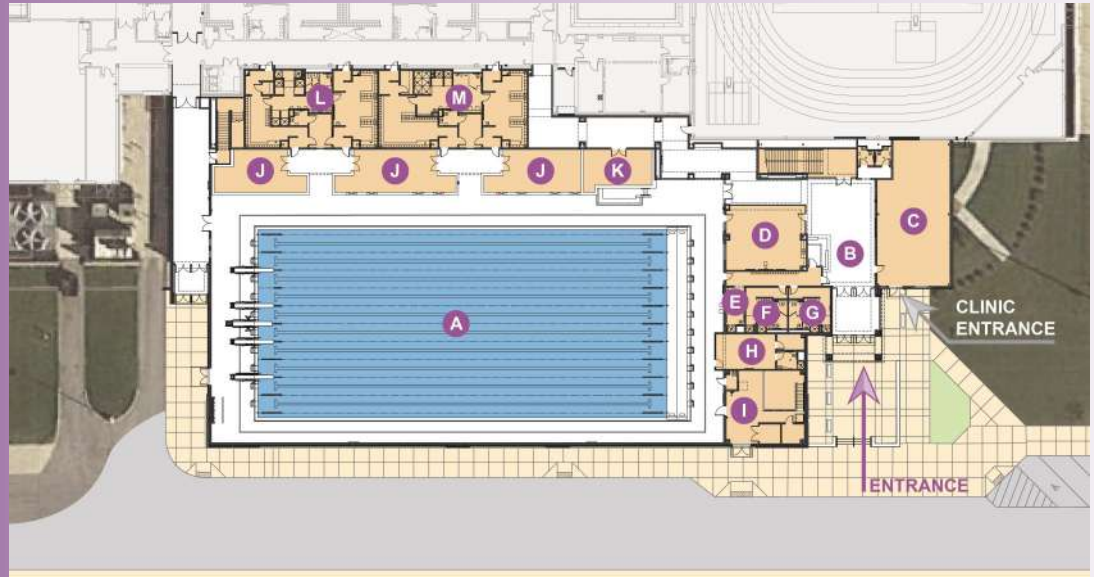

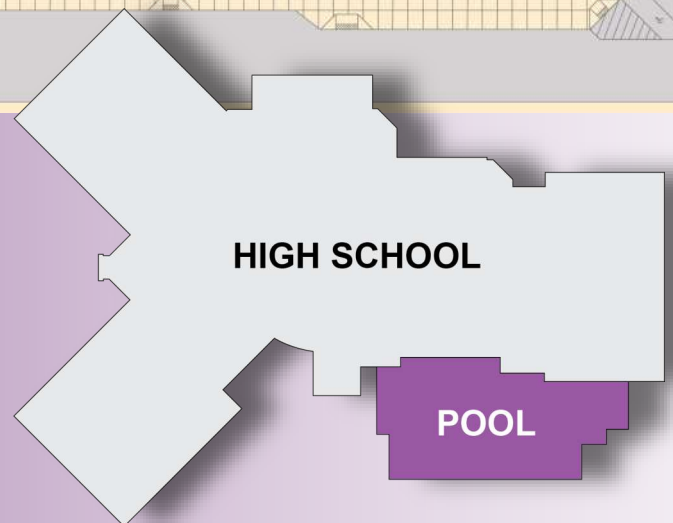
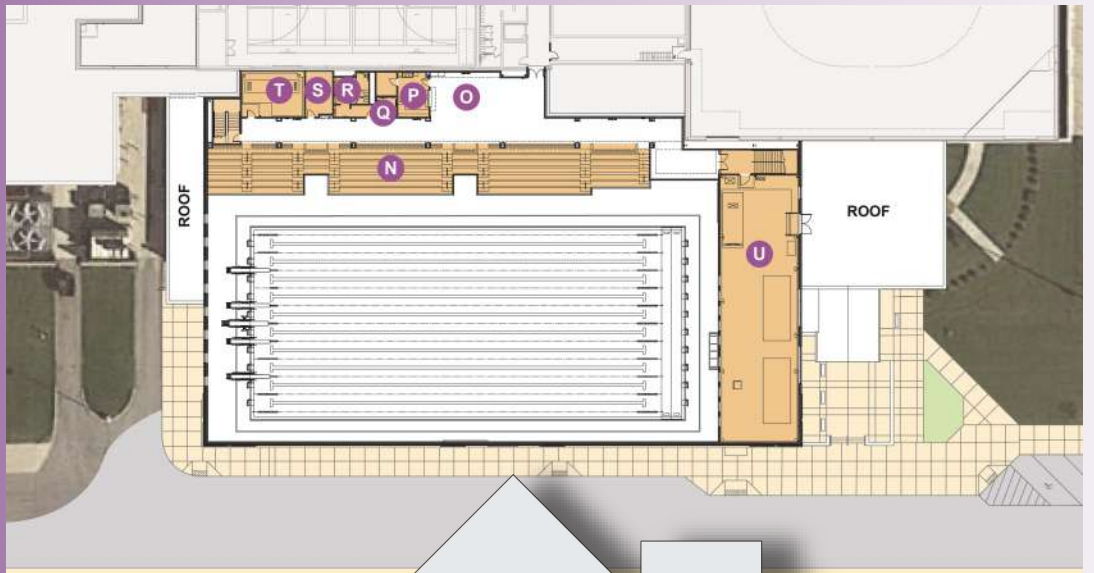

We offered the community a solution for building this structure without raising taxes through a referendum, and it was overwhelmingly supported by the citizens of Hobart. For many community members, this day will represent the culmination of their investment—reaching over years of meetings, volunteer activities, and communications. For our Brickies, this day represents more opportunities on our beautiful campus. Our district is blessed with tremendous resources, and we are forever grateful to the community of Hobart for their support!
