





Reading Performance: All Students



Writing Performance: All Students






2015 Fall Membership By Subgroup: Racial and Ethnic Groups



On-Time Graduation Rate Over Time: All Students









Sources of Financial Support and Total Per Pupil Expenditures for Operations










Free and Reduced Meal Eligibility: 2015-2016




Free and Reduced Breakfast Participation of Eligible Students
