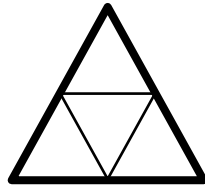
## You Can Count On It!

How many triangles are there in the figure at the right?  
How many parallelograms?

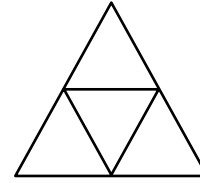
When counting shapes in a figure like this, you usually have to think of different sizes.



There are four small triangles.

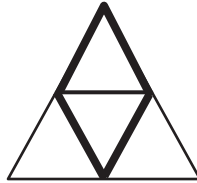


There is one large triangle.



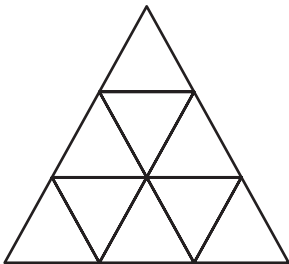
There are five triangles in all.

You also have to think of different positions.

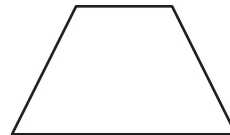


There are three parallelograms in all.
