2018 Indiana Middle School Bowling Program Highlights



The purpose of the Indiana Middle School Bowling Program will be to provide middle school (and home schooled) students,



grades 5, 6, 7 & 8, the opportunity to experience the spirit of competition, school and community pride. The program, available to both boys and girls will bridge barriers of size, age, strength, sex, race and handicap, providing opportunities for those who want to learn to compete in a growing youth sport.

We are going to provide a program that can become a feeder program for the Indiana High School Bowling teams. Mike Aulby's Arrowhead Bowl local program will take place from **March 5th – May 9th, 2018.** All bowlers will be entered in regional tournament competition where they will compete for a state championship. The tournament will run the two Saturdays prior to the Memorial Day weekend **May 12 & May 19, 2018).**

The registration cost to bowl in the program is just \$40 per student. This will cover the cost of an official IMSB T-shirt, tournament awards, and singles entry into a regional tournament. **(Note: Registration cost after March 12th will be \$50)**. There will be a \$5 fee for United State Bowling Congress (USBC) sanction fee and program awards for those not already USBC members.

Beginning March 5th, bowlers will practice every Monday from 4:30 pm to 5:45 pm and will bowl 3 games of singles competition every Wednesday beginning March 7th at 4:30 pm for 8 sessions **(No practice or competition during spring break).** Cost for practice and competition is \$9.00 per week. A \$5 fee will be charged if a bowler misses a week of competition. **Pre-bowls or post-bowls will not be allowed.**

Bowlers MUST complete a minimum 5 practices and 15 games of competition to be eligible for the Indiana Middle School Bowling State Tournament.
