

### Art 1 and 2 School Closure Work

Choose one to complete each day - either the drawing or writing assignment. Do not do the days out of order.

**Turning in Work** - There will be a daily Google Classroom assignment to post an image of your drawing assignment or attach a Google Doc or image of your written assignment.

Day	Drawing Assignment	Written Assignment
1	Draw your hand in an interesting position and shade it	Create an imaginary interview with an artist. Minimum 12 questions. Focus on art and their work (inspirations, mediums, topics, etc.).
2	Create a logo for yourself and make a formal copy of your artist signature (done in ink and a minimum of an 1" high - as if you are signing an autograph book). Be sure to include a short description of how the logo represents you.	Choose an art movement or style. Identify 5 famous artists. List a work by each artist. Describe similar topics/themes in the works. Describe how the art style/technique/look is similar. Describe how each artist can be identified individually. Do you like this art time movement/style? Why or why not? Which artist did you like the most?
3	Choose an object (can be from an image). Draw the object in at least three different styles (ex. cartoon, realistic, anime, gesture, abstract, etc.). Shade according to the style type you chose.	Find a piece of art. List the title and artist. Write a short description of what the piece looks like. Now, create a poem (5-10 lines) inspired by or about something in the piece.
4	Create a new character for an existing cartoon, tv show, anime, or video game. Be sure to include a short description of the character including name, personality, brief backstory, and how you think it would fit in the program you chose.	Describe how color schemes (monochromatic, primary, secondary, complementary, split complementary, etc.) are used in an animated tv show, comic strip, or anime/manga. You cannot use Scooby Doo.
5	Complete an object study - One object from four different angles (shaded)	Find a piece of art. List the title and artist. Write a short description of the piece. Now, describe how and why that piece would be different if it was created by a different artist or in a different artistic time period - be specific which alternate artist or time period you are choosing.
