

- **5.** Using different amounts of white and black with one hue. (**monochromatic**)
- **8.** A Japanese art style which translates to "light-dark harmony". (**notan**)
- **10.** Three colors evenly spaced on the color wheel. (**triadic**)
- **12.** Refers to point perspective where the bottom of buildings are closer to the viewer (**worm eye view**)
- **13.** A hue with white added. (**tint**)
- **14.** This technique is used to get the proper placement and proportions of human features. (**rule of thirds**)
- **16.** Is the concept relating to how an object seems smaller the farther away it gets. (**point perspective**)
- **17.** Refers to point perspective where the tops of buildings are closer to the viewer. (**bird eye view**)
- **18.** Is the projection of a figure apart from the ground or plane on which it is formed. (**relief**)
- **19.** A movement in modern art that imitates the methods, styles, and themes of popular culture and mass media (**pop art**)
- **20.** A hue with black added (**shade**)
- **21.** A substance made from paper pulp that can be molded when wet, hardens as it dries and can be painted when dry. (**paper mache**)
- **22.** Uses one image to create a repeating, interlocking work of art. (**tessellation**)

- 1. Uses hand engraved or carved blocks of wood or linoleum. (block printing)
- **2.** Three to five colors beside each other on the color wheel. (**analogous**)
- **3.** The colors which are located in between the primary and secondary colors. (**tertiary**)
- **4.** Is when the lines of an image that are cut into the ground on which it is formed. (**intaglio**)
- **5.** Is a circle design that uses radial symmetry. (mandala)
- **6.** The pure form of a color. (**hue**)
- **7.** A fluid or viscous substance used for writing or printing (**ink**)
- **9.** The area or space on a work of art in which the space is occupied by the subject. (**positive space**)
- **11.** Is the space around and between the subject(s) of an image (**negative space**)
- **15.** Set of 2 colors across from each other on the color wheel. (**complementary**)
