Introductory Art Courses

The following courses may be applied toward the Art requirement for graduation. No pre-requisite is required, open to all grades.

Five Credit Fine Arts Sequence

Students who complete the following five credit Fine Arts Sequence for a Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation will be exempt from the three credit second language mandate.

ONE of these credits must be from an Introductory Level Course. The remaining 4 credits can be from ANY other courses, including other introductory level courses, advanced level courses, or Career Training Courses.

Career Training Program 3 Credits for 3 Periods Daily

CTE Communication Design: Advertising - Level 2
Grade 12 only
