



District Focus:



You will be creating a piece of artwork about yourself this week!

Creating artwork about yourself can be tricky. It takes confidence and determination! You will be thinking about your culture and what that means and looks like to you! Will you create a piece of artwork in a way you are comfortable with? With art materials that you love? OR! Could you challenge yourself like Art and create artwork about yourself with materials and pictures that make you nervous? Your artwork can be large or small, digital or physically.



Students can work on the project in 20-minute sessions each day OR complete it in one sitting.




