- Students are to come in an immediately get their artwork and supplies. If we are working on a continuing project you should be working. If we are beginning a new project supplies will be listed on the board. These supplies should be out and ready to use.
- 2. Students must be inside the room before the bell finishes ringing in order not to be tardy. School policy applies.
- 3. Students are supplied all art materials EXCEPT for <u>regular pencils</u>, <u>erasers</u> and <u>rulers</u>. Students are held accountable for the supplies they are issued.

- 6. Assignments must be in before grading periods (trimester.). After that time they become 0's. Assignments are given a last day to work on in class, and then given a final due date.
- 7. Students are to clean up when the time is announced. Time may vary due to messiness of projects.
