

ART ROOM BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

1. Students are to come in and immediately get their artwork and supplies. If we are working on a continuing project you should be working. If we are beginning a new project supplies will be listed on the board. These supplies should be out and ready to use.
2. Students must be inside the room before the bell finishes ringing in order not to be tardy. School policy applies.
3. Students are supplied all art materials EXCEPT for regular pencils, erasers and rulers. Students are held accountable for the supplies they are issued.
4. Students are responsible for checking with the teacher on work missed during absences.
5. Students are expected to be quiet and attentive during demonstrations.
6. Assignments must be in before grading periods (trimester.). After that time they become 0's. Assignments are given a last day to work on in class, and then given a final due date.
7. Students are to clean up when the time is announced. Time may vary due to messiness of projects.
8. Students are allowed to listen to music devices BUT not when I am talking AND I do not want to be able to hear the music.

CLASS RULES

1. Always RESPECT one another and one another's artwork.
2. NEVER play with the paper cutter.
3. You may TALK while you Work as long as you WORK while you TALK!
4. Don't ask you can't go.
