Being a real artist doesn't mean you have fancy art supplies. Real artists search for materials everywhere!



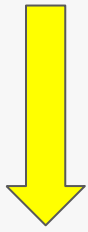
If you run out of art supplies, you can still make art by being creative and recycling!

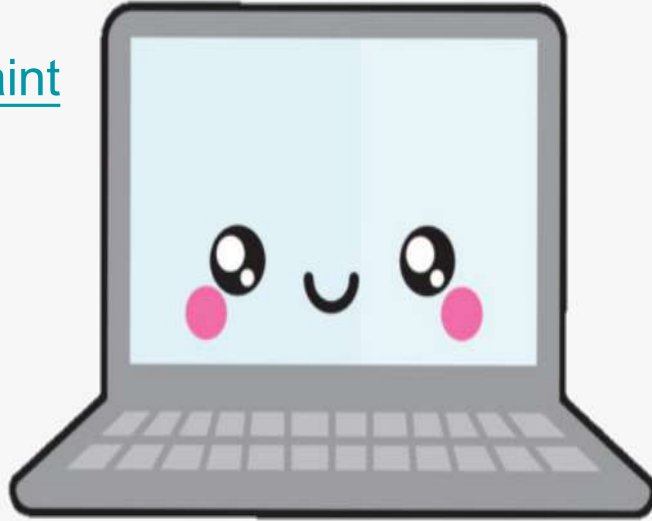

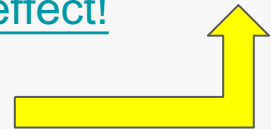

darker color



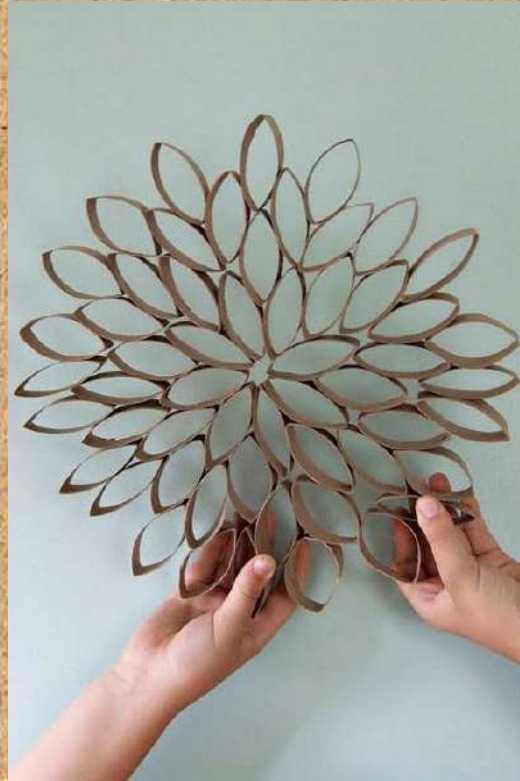


**You can also use beets to make pink ink!**



Cut some beets, cook them in a pot with water for 20 minutes, then drain the pink water into a cup. You can eat the beets AND use the water for ink!

**Use nature! Rocks, leaves, flowers, and sticks can all be used to make art.**

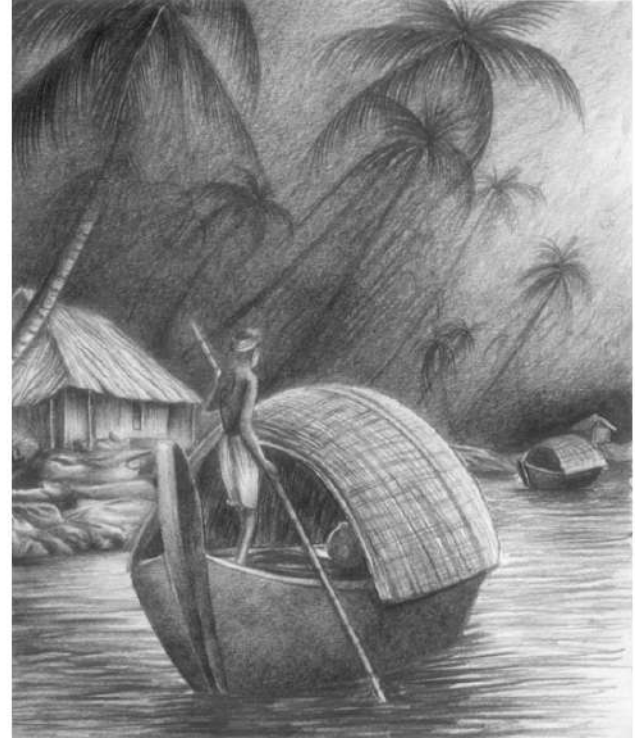




**Make temporary drawings and messages on the sidewalk with water!**
