

4th Grade "River of Dreams" Experience



The Clearbrook-Gonvick fourth grade class have been working with the International Water Institute to learn about river watersheds in our area. Each student has designed and colored sixteen inch cedar canoes and launched

them into the Clearwater River. Each canoe has a personalized ID number and when someone finds the canoe on the river, they are hoping the kind discoverer will go to the listed website (riverofdreams.org) and record the current location of the canoe and once again send it on its journey. On this website you can find the student's personal dream which they have written and a picture of their canoe. The students are hoping their canoes follow the Clearwater River, Red Lake River, and the Red River, through Lake Winnipeg and have them one-day reach Hudson Bay.
