- Cardboard (something to catch extra paint)




Cezanne apples

Materials:

- Paper
- Something to color with!





Calder Sculpture



Materials:

- Paper
- Crayon or colored pencil
- Scissors

- Fold your paper in half
- Starting at the folded side and curving down, draw curved lines like a rainbow.
- Cut along the lines leaving a little space along the fold.
- Unfold and open up.
- Pull the legs left and right until the sculpture stands























Cezanne apples



Materials:

- Paper
- pencil
- something to color with

- 1. Draw the circles that fill up most of the page (not perfect)
- 2. Add a "V" shape for apple stems
- 3. Make a large circle around the apples
- 4. Add patterns in the background
- 5. Color along the *Left* side of each apple, making a "C" shape
- 6. Color or paint the apple
- 7. Color the background
