- Cardboard (something to catch extra paint)

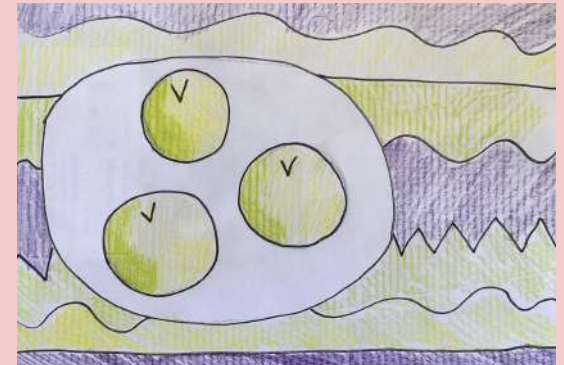


Cezanne apples

- Something to color with!





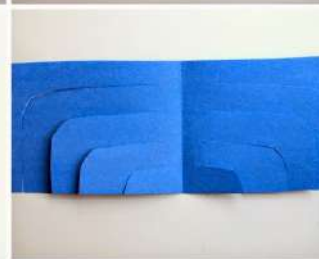
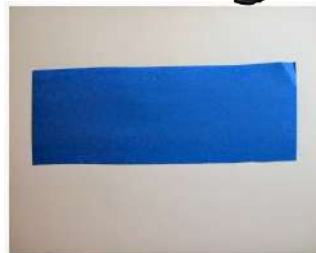
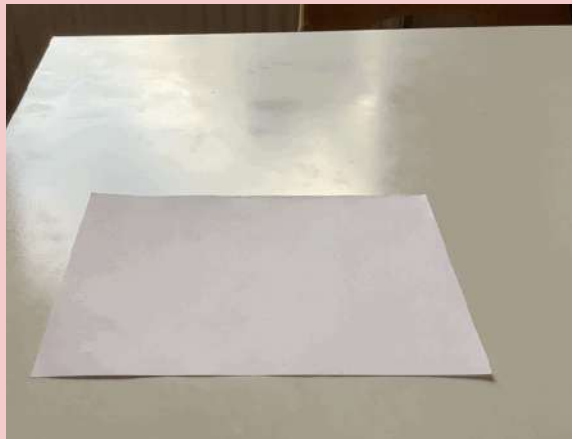
Calder Sculpture



Materials:

- Paper
- Crayon or colored pencil
- Scissors

1. Fold your paper in half
2. Starting at the folded side and curving down, draw curved lines like a rainbow.
3. Cut along the lines leaving a little space along the fold.
4. Unfold and open up.
5. Pull the legs left and right until the sculpture stands



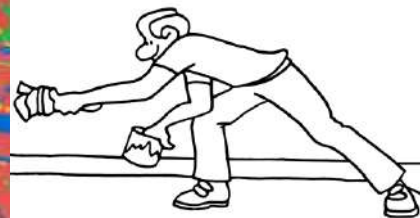
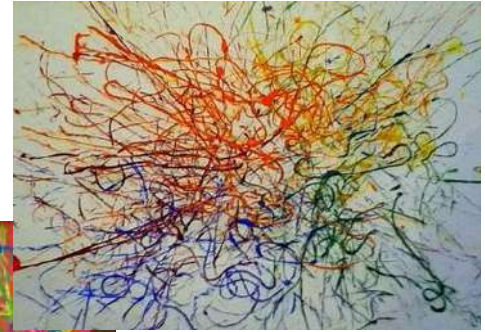
Pollock Painting



Materials:

- Paper
- Paint
- Water
- String
- cardboard or plastic
(something to protect surfaces)

1. Find some plastic or cardboard to protect your table
2. Lay out your paper
3. Dip your string in paint (keep part to hold on to!)
4. Pull your string around the paper to make marks
5. Add more paint as you need
6. You can also change color





Cezanne apples



Materials:

- Paper
- pencil
- something to color with

1. Draw the circles that fill up most of the page (not perfect)
2. Add a "V" shape for apple stems
3. Make a large circle around the apples
4. Add patterns in the background
5. Color along the *Left* side of each apple, making a "C" shape
6. Color or paint the apple
7. Color the background
