



Arts Council of the Eastern Shore, Inc. Scholarship Program

The Arts Council of the Eastern Shore (ACES) is a non-profit, volunteer organization dedicated to the cultural enrichment of the people of Accomack and Northampton Counties. Each year the Arts Council is proud to offer scholarships to graduating high school seniors and current college students who are residents of the Eastern Shore and who plan to pursue a career in the arts (e.g., the performing arts, visual arts or arts education). The Arts Council determines the number of recipients and the total scholarship amounts depending on qualifications of the applicants and available funding. The scholarship is awarded to the recipient for the purpose of defraying college tuition, room and board, and textbook expenses. Scholarship recipients will be announced by mid-May. Recipients will have the opportunity to share their artwork at the awards ceremony on June 7 at Ker Place in Onancock.

Applicant Eligibility

The student must:

1. Be a resident of the Eastern Shore of Virginia.
2. Plan to pursue a career in the arts, including theater, music, dance, fine arts, ceramic arts, photography, computer graphics, creative writing (i.e., playwriting, poetry, etc.) and arts education.
3. Have maintained a grade point average of C+ or 2.5 on a 4-point scale.

Please submit the following information:

1. Completed application form.
2. Two (2) letters of reference. (One from a tutor/educator in your discipline and one personal from someone who knows you well, e.g. a neighbor, minister, scout leader, coach, etc.) (NOTE: Previous award recipients need not provide these letters.)
3. An official grade transcript from the high school or college must be sent to the address below.
4. A composition (at least 300 words) describing your involvement in the arts, why art inspires you and your career goals in the arts.
5. Graduating High School Seniors provide a letter of acceptance from the college.
