- A 2-D image (drawing, painting, print, digital, animation, collage, stitchery, etc) Have your image/s and background FILL the entire page.
- A 3-D project (sculpture, assemblage, etc) or a performance / video.

Group Artwork:

- A mural, quilt, installation, performance video, poem, song of peace, theater or dance piece.
 - SPECIAL INVITATION: If you would like to nominate your class/team for a collaborative opportunity with a peer school/community organization and a professional artist, please fill out this simple interest form ASAP! We aim to make partnerships by early April.



Content Guidelines:

- Be sure your work is appropriate for all ages and cultures. This is a call for Peace. Our goal is to be inclusive and inspirational.
- Keep it PG rated.
- Use of copyrighted material is prohibited. Here are resources for free public domain music (bensound.com) and pictures (<u>pexels.com</u> and <u>unsplash.com</u>)

- Only one entry per student will be accepted.
- Parents/guardians understand that the submission of artwork grants full usage to the World Culture Festival and its organizing partners. Please see full terms of submission.
- Parents/guardians are advised to keep the original in case interested galleries request them.

- Only one entry per team/group or individual will be accepted
- Teachers understand that the digital submission of students' artwork grants full usage to the World Culture Festival and its organizing partners. Please see full terms in submission.
- Teachers / Artists are advised to keep the original work in case interested galleries request them or there are opportunities for further exhibition.

- Individual Artwork
 - Upload one high resolution digital image or max 90 second HD video (minimum of 720p, 1280 x 720). Accepted digital file formats: jpg, png, pdf. Accepted video file formats: mov and mp4.
 - Parents/Guardians please fill out the Entry and Release Form for each student under 18.

Group Artwork

- Up to three digital high resolution images (700 x 700 min) of the project in its entirety, or an HD video (minimum of 720p, 1280 x 720, 1 minute max).
- An additional HD video (3 minute max) about the collaborative process, including students' reflections and learnings. Accepted video file formats: mov and mp4.
- Share on social media with the following hashtags #Arts4Peace2023.

Evaluation Criteria for all All Artists Showcases:

- Original interpretation of the question: "What does peace look like?".
- Creativity.
- Memorable Inspires Action for Peace.
- Harmony in diversity (race, gender, age, disability, opinions).

For Group Pieces additional criteria include:

- Demonstrates the participation of diverse voices.
- Description of the collaborative process as included in your accompanying reflection video.
