Scholarship Selection Criteria:

1. Applicants potential for benefiting from and making use of Vocational, Technical or College training program that is designed to lead to gainful employment, and
2. The applicants character and leadership ability, as evidenced by the applicants scholastic performance as well as the applicants performance in vocational and
3. Proof of enrollment at an accredited school of higher learning in the semester following high school graduation. The scholarship money is to be used for tuition and books and will be sent directly to the institutions business office after the participants first successful semester has been completed and he/she has provided evidence to the scholarship committee.
4. Applicants must submit two letters of recommendation along with the attached completed application to the selection committee.
5. The recipients of these scholarships will be announced at their High School graduation.
