PART ONE (pages 152-164)

- 1. Explain what Gene finds the boys to be doing when he returns from Vermont. Why is Gene relieved to find this is going on? (152-154).
- 2. Gene describes the photos on his wall as "a barefaced lie about my background" (156). Explain why you think Gene created this "false identity" (156).
- 3. Describe Brinker's reaction to Gene's news about Leper being "Absent Without Leave" (156-157). Provide a trait for Brinker based on this reaction. **[QUOTE]**
- 4. As graduation comes closer, most of the senior boys are making plans for enlistment. Gene states he "didn't feel free" to take any action himself (159). Why do you think he feels this way?
