Authentic Assessment	
Is realistically contextualized – the prompt considers	
real-life scenarios and settings	
Replicates key situations that test adults in a "real"	
setting, such as work, home, civic life, etc. –	
Demonstrates the complexities that accompany solving a	
real-world problem	
Requires judgment and innovation to perform – the	
student has to use what they have learned and decipher	
how it fits into their world	
Asks students to "do" the subject – this goes beyond	
"fill-in-the-blank" and has the student solve the problem	
in a new or novel way	
Assess the student's ability to use their knowledge and	
skills solve complex problems – looks at the problem as	
a whole and not isolated into specific parts	
Performance Tasks	
The assessment includes:	
A setting and role of the characters;	
a goal or challenge for the students;	
a product or performance for students to complete;	
an audience (National Health Education Standards,	
2007).
