The ASVAB Exam will be administered on () at Caston Jr-Sr High School. The test will start at 8:35 AM and will finish during 4th period. Please make sure to go to your testing area as soon as possible in the morning so you are ready to go.

The ASVAB offers an excellent Career Exploration Program. After the exam, I will meet with you to teach you how to utilize this tool. Another benefit of this program is that you can earn your graduation pathway by doing well on the ASVAB. The minimum score to use as a graduating pathway is a 31.

There are 8 parts to the ASVAB, but only 4 parts will count towards the score we need. They are Arithmetic Reasoning, Word Knowledge, Paragraph Comprehension, and Math Knowledge. The other four parts are used to place you in the military and for career explorations. Those parts include General Science, Electronic Information, Auto and Shop Information, and Mechanical Comprehension. A high score means a wider range of opportunities for those who are planning a career in the military.

You can prepare for this exam. There are several on-line sites where you can get practice and see the types of questions that you will encounter. Below are a few of those sites:

If you are practicing, I would concentrate on the Math and English parts of the exam. It is a timed test and you will need to work at a steady pace to finish each part. Practicing will help you know if you are working at the correct pace. You cannot use a calculator on the math parts unless you have an IEP or 504 Plan that allows this type of accommodation. If you have and use accommodations, you cannot use that score to enter the military. Let me know if you have an IEP or 504 Plan but want to use the score to get into the military.
