### Shakopee High School 2021/22 Back to School Information

Dear Shakopee High School Families:

Welcome to the 2021-2022 school year! I hope this letter finds you all healthy and excited for the start of the new school year. After all of the challenges of the previous year, I'm very much looking forward to getting back to more "normal" routines with the understanding that we still have to be mindful of health and safety guidance.

We cannot wait to open up our building to the 2,800 incoming students on Tuesday, September 7th. Our facilities, combined with the academy model, creates a welcoming, inclusive environment within a large high school setting. I am extremely proud of the learning opportunities our teachers and staff create for our students on a daily basis.

<u>Schedule Pick-up Days</u>: We will be hosting schedule pick-up days on the following dates. There are specific times/days allotted for each grade to help ensure a positive experience. If you cannot make your assigned session, you can attend at another time during the 8am - 4pm block on either day. Pre-purchased parking permits can be picked up at this time. School photos will be taken for the yearbook and photo ID. 2020/21 Yearbooks can also be picked up at this time. Future 2021/22 yearbooks will be available to order after school starts.

- 9th Grade: Wednesday, August 25, Noon-4pm NOTE: MacBooks can be picked up during this timeframe if an Agreement form is on file.

<u>Open House</u>: We will also host an Open House on Tuesday, August 31 from 4-7pm where the same schedule and yearbook pick-up activities will be available in addition to the opportunity to meet teachers and experience the high school first hand!

We are requesting that families complete all back to school paperwork in a digital format before schedules are picked up. Belows are QR codes that will take you to all forms that need to be completed for the upcoming school year including health, technology, free and reduced meal/educational benefits and other forms.

In an effort to address the financial challenges continuing to impact Shakopee Public Schools, the School Board, during the July 19th school board business meeting, unanimously approved a special election to bring an operating levy before the voters on November 2, 2021.
