# HELPFUL HINTS FOR FAMILIES...

- Provide an area for your child for their distance learning
  - Give them a choice of where they will learn best
  - Make sure that they are free from distractions
- Establish “school” routines
  - Getting up and having breakfast before distance learning
  - Being dressed and ready to learn
  - Using breaks to go outside, get a snack, and stretch if needed
- Parents’ role in Distance Learning
  - As a parent you are a supporter and a person that celebrates their accomplishments with them, not their teacher!
  - Focus should be on the process, not necessarily the product.
