



Beginning August 11th, parents can preorder meal bundles that will include five days of breakfast and lunch for each student. Pre-ordered meal bundles will be available for parent pick up at the assigned locations or may be delivered to the student's CMS bus stop. Parents will receive a confirmation email when placing an order. When picking up meal bundles, parents will need to provide the student's name and student ID number or present their student identification card.

Meals will be charged to the student's meal account based on their current free, reduced or paid meal status. Parents are encouraged to complete a 2020-2021 family meal application to see if they qualify for meal benefits. The online application can be completed by visiting our website at www.cms.k12.nc.us, clicking on departments, School Nutrition Services, Free & Reduced meals.

Students enrolled in Community Eligible Provision (CEP) schools will not be charged for breakfast or lunch. Parents do not need to complete a meal application if all students in the household attend a CEP school. For a list of CEP schools please visit our website at www.cms.k12.nc.us, click on departments, School Nutrition Services, Community Eligibility Provision (CEP).

Meal bundles will be preordered using our current online payment system PayPAMS. Parents that have not previously registered their students for this service, will need to do so to be able to preorder meal bundles. There is no fee to the parent for using this service.

To sign up, parents will go to www.PayPAMS.com and click on the "SIGN UP NOW!" button on the home page. Select NC, then select Charlotte Mecklenburg Schools. Create a username and password and enter your contact information. Add your children to your account.

- Paid students may purchase a five-day meal bundle for \$15.00.


