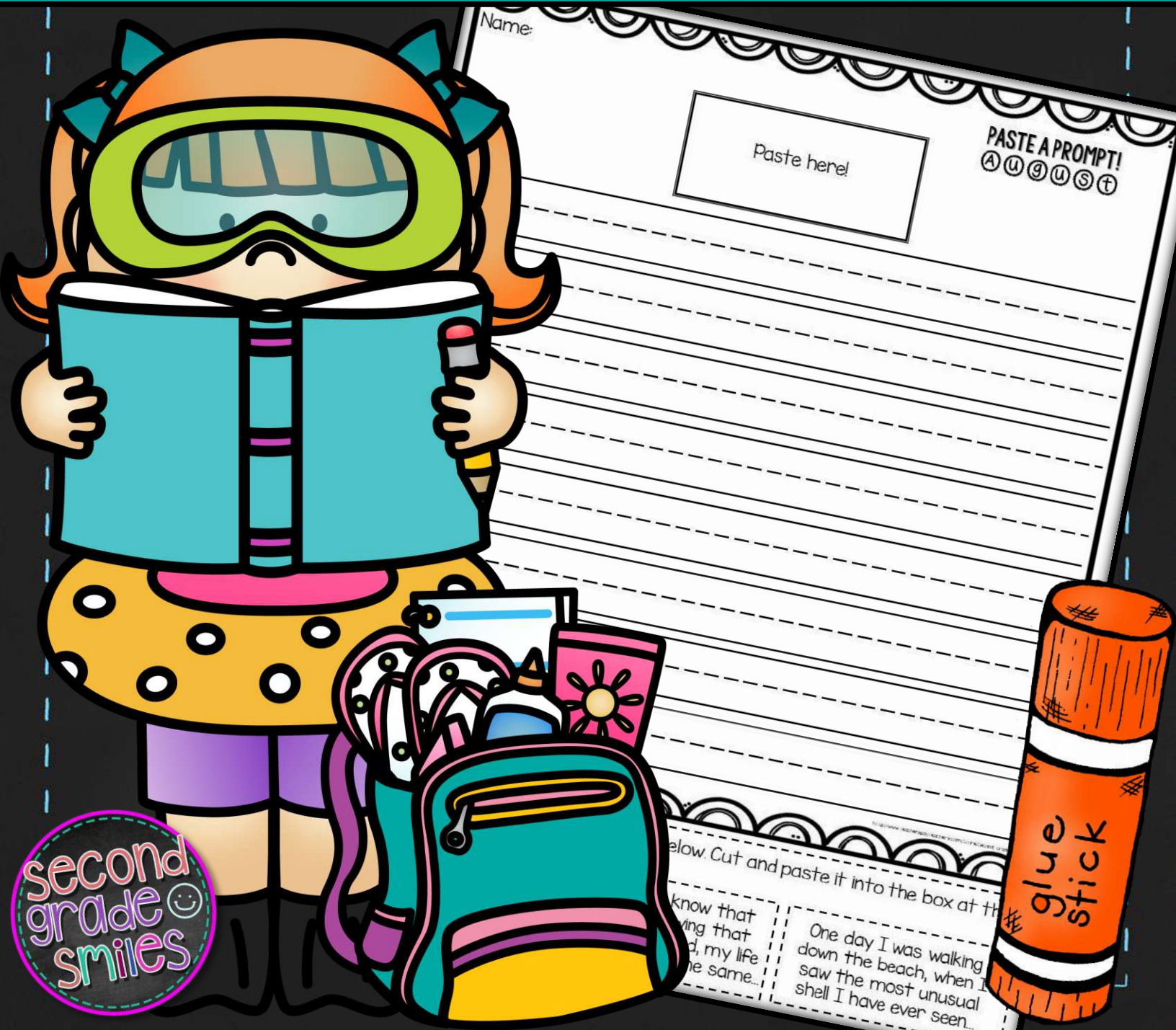

A Note to the Teacher...

Thank you for your purchase! This August Paste a Prompt writing prompt set was created to motivate reluctant writers by offering elements of choice while still ensuring that students practice personal narrative, informative/expository, opinion, descriptive, and creative writing.

A total of 11 unique print-and-go Paste a Prompt pages are included. Each page gives students three choices of prompt, located at the bottom of the page. Students then cut out and paste the desired prompt into the box at the top of the page and write their responses to the prompt below.

Two of the included pages provide personal narrative writing prompt options. Another two offer expository/informative writing opportunities in the form of "how-to" writing prompts. (No outside research should be necessary.) An additional two prompts provide opinion writing options. Two more provide descriptive writing prompt choices, and two provide creative writing prompt opportunities. A bonus mixed practice back to school prompt page is also included.

All pages are provided with three line options. Choose the option that best fits the needs of your students.

Bordered blank lined pages and picture spaces are also included to copy onto the back of the page should your students need additional room to write or illustrate their responses.

These work well in writing centers, but could also be done as a whole class activity.
