

printers, and more!





Have you ever watched a computer-animated movie and wondered how animators and designers made objects look and appear realistic? The environments and characters are created using 3D modeling tools. These technological tools are not just used to create awesome special effects and movies. Many physical objects you use every day are first created using 3D modeling, also called solid modeling.



8th Grade Exploring Business Activities



Entrepreneurship-

We start by introducing the basics of Entrepreneurship to benefit students who did not take the 7th grade course. For Entrepreneurship "veterans" it's a useful review of concepts they might have last thought about in a year.

Four Functions of

Management — Students learn the four functions of management (Leading, Planning, Organizing, and Controlling). For a formal project, they score small business owners featured on the TV show "Billion Dollar Buyer" on how well they perform each function.







Students learn how to identify the Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats of different businesses. They then present an analysis of a company of their choice of what it's doing right, what it could do better, and what its chances are of keeping up with the competition.




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

In 7th grade orchestra we build upon skills from 6th grade such as:



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


