

## ***Grade 8 Graduation Drive-by Ceremony at Baker School***

Dear Baker Grade 8 Families:

While we are disappointed that we are unable to hold a traditional graduation ceremony, we are excited to be able to celebrate your graduate(s) with a brief certificate passing, cheers from staff, and congratulations at Baker School!

**We request that you strongly consider traveling to Baker School via car, if possible, in consideration of social distancing and safety. While this may not seem eco-friendly, it will help us meet the guidelines provided by the Health Department. If you are walking on the Baker School grounds or outside of your car during the certificate passing and picture-taking, you must be wearing a face mask.**

### ***Start of Drive-by Ceremony:***

Traveling by car: Families arrive at Baker School per their assigned time and line up on Beverly Road along the playground/field until notified to proceed forward. The traffic director will signal the driver/walker to enter the circle and move forward to the marked certificate passing area.

For families who have driven: Family members remain in the car at the marked waiting area.

**One parent/guardian and 8th grade student** approach the congratulatory space to be greeted from a distance by Principal Lewis, Vice Principal Howe, and Vice Principal English-Sand. The graduating student takes the Baker School Certificate and gift bag from the table, turns toward the parent/guardian who takes a picture, and returns to their car with the waiting family. Families exit the Baker School grounds by following the one-way drive to Beverly Rd.

If you walk: Families arrive at Baker School per their assigned time and line up on the Beverly Road sidewalk along the playground/field maintaining social distancing guidelines. The traffic director will signal the walkers to enter the circle and proceed along the sidewalk to the marked certificate passing area. Family members remain on the sidewalk in the marked waiting area.

**One parent/guardian and 8th grade student** approach the congratulatory space to be greeted from a distance by Principal Lewis, Vice Principal Howe, and Vice Principal English-Sand. The graduating student takes the Baker School Certificate and gift bag from the table, turns toward the parent/guardian who takes a picture, and returns to the sidewalk with the waiting family.
