Early Life

Obama was born in 1961 in the state of Hawaii. His parents divorced shortly after he was born, and his father later died in a car accident when Obama was 21 years old. When he got out of college, he planned large projects for different businesses to get some experience. After working in these jobs he decided to visit Kenya to meet some of his relatives on his father's side of the family. This made a major impact on Barry. Obama also started and took part in various organizations to help others in the community.

Law School

Next, Obama attended the prestigious Harvard Law School in 1988. He quickly rose to become the president of the Harvard Law Journal. Obama eventually taught Constitutional Best law schools according Law at Chicago Law School. Obama was a lawyer and had an active law license until 2007.



#### Political Life

Barack Obama became a state senator from Illinois in 1997. Obama worked as a senator until 2008, when he was elected to be the President of the United States. During Obama's presidency, he focused on issues such as gun control, health care reform, foreign policy, and more. A major event that Obama gave the executive order for was the killing of Osama bin Laden, who was the leader of al-Queda, the terrorists who flew planes into several U.S. buildings on September II, 2001. Obama was reelected in 2012 and his presidency ended in 2016, when Donald Trump became president.



Family Life

Many describe Barry as a loyal family man. He has two daughters, Sasha and Malia, and a wife, Michelle. The First Lady of the United States, Michelle, focused on healthy eating and exercise for children and in schools. The Obamas also looked for hypo-allergenic dogs to live in the Whitehouse with them. They brought home two Portuguese Water Dogs, Bo and Sunny. Many describe Obama as intelligent, charismatic, and personable.
